Bloomberg drops out, backs Biden



Billionaire and former New York Mayor Michael Bloomberg ended his presidential campaign on Wednesday and said he was backing Joe Biden for the Democratic Party's nomination to challenge President Donald Trump in the November election.

"A viable path to the nomination no longer exists," Bloomberg said in a statement, having failed to deliver convincing wins in his electoral debut on Super Tuesday despite lavish spending on campaign ads across the United States.

Endorsing Biden, Bloomberg said: "I will work to make him the next president of the United States."

His only victory on Tuesday came in the U.S. territory of American Samoa.

Amazon employee tests positive for H1N1

BS REPORTER Bengaluru, 4 March

A positive case of swine flu (H1N1) has been detected at the Bengaluru office of e-commerce giant Amazon. The employee, who did not show any signs of illness while at work and had stopped coming to work five days ago, said a source.

"As a precautionary measure, Amazon is sanitising the floor on which the employee worked. All employees who came in contact with the patient or to him going on leave have been informed," a source said. The company has advised these employees to work from home and take immediate medical help if they start showing any signs of flu. Amazon confirmed the development to Business Standard.

In another development, an employee of the research and development centre Mercedes Benz in Bengaluru was also tested positive for H1N1. As a precautionary measure, the company started sanitising its office as well, said a source.

Last month, two employees of software company SAP, too, had tested positive in Bengaluru. The Indian arm of the German software group company had temporarily shut down all offices in the country from February 28 for sanitisation.

CBSE approaches police over paper leak rumours

The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has approached the Delhi Police against fake news about a leak of exam papers being spread on social media, and advised parents and students not to believe them and panic.
